

28th Annual Oxford Fine Arts Fair

May 25, 26 & 27, 2012

The Oxford Fine Arts Fair is a juried show and sale held each Memorial Day weekend, this year showcasing the newly renovated Oxford Community Center building and grounds. The OCC is a non-profit 501(C)(3) organization.

EVENT DETAILS

Submit for Review: via e-mail (cindy@oxfordmd.com), 3 images of original work that would be for sale during the exhibit. Those of 300-350 ppi and a minimum 5x7 file size are recommended and may be used in advance publicity; slides will be accepted only with prior consent.

Entry Fee: include a \$15. non-refundable entry fee with the completed entry form

Deadline: entry submissions must be received by **Friday, November 18, 2011**

Notification: artists will be notified by early January, 2012

Artwork: Original pieces must comprise 75% of the artwork shown on graphic display panels, with no more than 25% framed prints of original work. Artists must bring additional pieces to restock after sales, and we encourage a range of sizes and pricing.

Exhibit Space: Two-dimensional artists will be provided with four 3'x6' black-covered graphic display panels, hooks for hanging, two light fixtures, one small table and a chair. Due to space limitations, no other accessories will be allowed within the exhibit space with the exception of one small artist-provided bin. Sculptors will be provided with one 3'x6' table and two pedestals, roughly 20"x20" and 24"x24". Artists who choose to exhibit outdoors may set up displays as they wish; graphic display panels may be available on site on a first-come, first-served basis.

Hours: The exhibit will be open for a Preview Party and sponsors' reception on Friday evening, 6-8 and to the general public on Saturday, 10-5 and on Sunday, 10-4. Artists must be present at the reception and must accompany their work on both days; volunteers will be available for lunch and other breaks.

Registration Fee & Financial Arrangements: Upon juried acceptance into the OFAF, there is a \$50. registration fee per exhibitor and a 30% commission on art sales during (or as a result of) the show. The Oxford Community Center provides a central cashier service with VISA/MasterCard acceptance, and will forward sales tax collected directly to the state on the artist's behalf. Two weeks or so following the exhibit's close, the Center will forward artists checks representing their sales less any credit card transaction fees, and less the 30% commission.

Accommodations: Artists who live at least 60 miles from Oxford are offered bed & breakfast opportunities in local, private residences at a cost of \$45./night (single) and \$55./night (double). These funds, also, go directly to the Oxford Community Center.

Attendance: The Oxford Fine Arts Fair has grown over the years to enjoy a reputation for quality works of art, fabulous volunteers and legendary strawberry shortcake . . . roughly 2,000 visitors attend each year. The exhibit will be well-advertised within our Mid-Shore area and beyond, and I look forward to receiving your entry.
